Both sides benefit from face-to-face contacts during which the host school provides accommodation, a round trip ticket, communication and a conducive environment that favors the learning of the host school culture and language. Acting as UNESCO Center for Peace Intern and representative, the English Teacher Ambassador provides English classes and assists the host school by nurturing global understanding. Four Positions are available for spring 2010.

➤ **Eligibility:**

Bachelor Degree holders with English as first language, Certified English Teachers and English major graduates a plus.

➤ **Application Process:**

The application process will begin December 1st throughout December 31st, 2009. Interview will be conducted early January and the finalist will depart the US in February 2010 to report to their school.
